## **House Committee to inquire into Road Safety Remuneration Bills**

The House of Representatives Infrastructure and Communications Committee is conducting a new inquiry into the **Road Safety Remuneration Bill 2011** and **Road Safety Remuneration (Consequential Amendments and Related Provisions) Bill 2011**. These Bills were introduced to the House on 23 November 2011 and referred by the Selection Committee on 24 November. The Bills propose to establish a new Road Safety Remuneration Tribunal with the power to determine mandatory minimum rates of pay for employed and self-employed commercial drivers.

The Committee is now inviting submissions from interested parties on the details of these bills.
