IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THE EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY BE RATIFIED. WE SUPPORT ANY AND ALL LAW ENFORCEMENT, INCLUDING THE DETECTION OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY AND THE PROSECUTION OF ALL CHILD MOLESTORS . THE COMPUTER AGE HAS BOUGHT WITH IT CRIMINAL ACTIVITY, WE AGREE WITH THE TREATY TO ALLOW THE PREVENTION OF CYBERCRIME , ALSO TO DEAL WITH FRAUD RELATED MATTERS . WE SUPPORT THE OVERVIEW AND NATIONAL SUMMARY IN RELATION TO SECTIONS 13., 14. WE DO HOWEVER WORRY ABOUT THOSE WHO PURCHASE A COMPUTER FROM ANOTHER PERSON WITHOUT KNOWING WHAT IS ON THE HARD DRIVE THAT MAY HAVE BEEN AN OFFENCE UNDER LAW. THESE PEOPLE MAY BE AN INNOCENT PARTY AND WOULD BE PROSECUTED. SERVICE PROVIDERS SHOULD BE PROSECUTED FOR ALLOWING THOSE IMAGES TO APPEAR ON THE COMPUTERS. A DUTY OF CARE SHOULD PREVAIL TO STOP ALL OF THE IMAGES OF CHILD PORNOGRAPHY BEING DISPLAYED. THE EXECUTIVE WISH TO SEE THAT LEGISLATION BE INTRODUCED TO FORCE SERVICE PROVIDERS TO SCREEN ALL TRANSMISSIONS. COSTS ARE OF A NORMAL CONCERN BUT IN RELATION TO FIGHTING CRIME WE UNDERSTAND THAT COSTS MUST BE MET. THE EXECUTIVE WISH TO THANK THE COMMITTEE FOR ALLOWING US TO COMMENT ON THIS TREATY.
