### INFORMATION FOR CONFERENCE DELEGATES

- Limited free parking is available all day in the underground car park beneath the Forecourt of the building. Surface car park areas are located on Federation Mall, between Parliament House and Old Parliament House. Those delegates with building access are encouraged to use alternative underground car parks.
- It is a condition of entry to Parliament House that you consent to personal security screening and x-ray screening of any items you bring into Parliament House. Once you have been screened and issued with a pass by Parliamentary Security Officers, you will be escorted to the conference registration desk. It is recommended you arrive between 8:00-8:30am to allow time for these procedures before the conference commences.
- On registration, you will be issued with a conference name badge, which should be worn all day.
- A map detailing the location of conference activities, toilets etc, is on the back of conference packs.
- Tea and Coffee will be available all day. A light lunch of sandwiches will also be available from 12:30pm. Other food and refreshment items are available for purchase from The Queen's Terrace Café, located on the 1st floor (open from 9:30am to 4:30pm).
- Hearing Loops are available in all conference rooms. If you put your hearing aid to the 'T' switch you will have access to the loop.
- Please ensure your mobile phone is either turned off, or switched to silent mode during all conference proceedings.
- Scheduling is tight, with a large number of presentations during the day. Therefore it is important for delegates to arrive on time, and be punctual in returning from breaks.
