Ms Mary Ann O'Loughlin, Executive Councillor, COAG Reform Council (CRC) will appear before the Joint Committee of Public Accounts and Audit on **Wednesday, 20 March 2013** from **12:00pm to 1:00pm** in **Committee Room 2R1**, Parliament House, Canberra.

The Committee has called the CRC to examine two areas:

- the Government's response to JCPAA Report 427 into National Funding Agreements, and progress of the CRC in relation to its role assisting 'COAG to strengthen the performance and public accountability of governments'; and
- progress on the COAG's national Indigenous reform agenda, complementing the JCPAA's current inquiry into three Australian National Audit Office reports on Indigenous programs.
