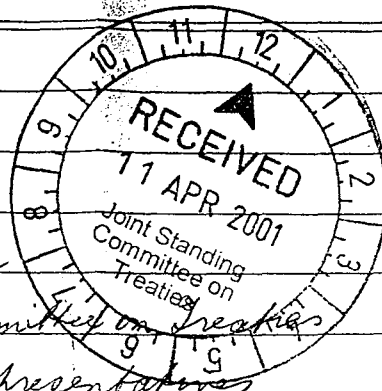

Dear Sir,

The Australian Government would be extremely unwise to ratify any treaties which allows unelected foreign bureaucrats to dictate laws which have not been passed after debate in the Australian Parliament.

Such action would pass sovereignty over, beyond our control, to any group who could influence and interfere directly and powerfully in Australian domestic affairs, arrest, try, and imprison our citizens.

The U.N. was originally perceived as an organisation for good—but is no more.

Therefore I object to the surrender of sovereignty which is unwarranted, unjustified, un-democratic and un-Australian.
