JOINT STANDING COMMITTEE

DEAR SIRS.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THIS

SHALL BE INCAPABLE OF BEING CHOSEN OR SITTING AS A

SENATOR OR HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES MEMBER. IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THIS EXECUTIVE THAT OATH WOULD BE BROKEN, BY THE MEMBERS.

I REFER TO ARTICLE 15 , OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIGENOUS PERSONS. THIS EXECUTIVE FIND THAT STATEMENT TO BE RACIST.

THE INDIGENOUS PEOPLE DO NOT WANT TO BE TREATED AS THEY ARE DIFFERENT FROM ANY OTHER AUSTRALIAN.

I HAVE ABORIGINAL BLOOD I FIND THAT STATEMENT OFFENSIVE, TO ALL AUSTRALIANS.

THE ABORIGINAL NATION ARE THE FOUNDERS, THE W.T.O. ARE THE THIEVES, THIS TREATY IS SUPPOSED TO REPRESENT A LEVEL PLAYING FIELD, THAT IS A JOKE.



COMMENT ON THIS TREATY.

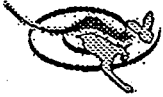
