

ON TREATIES. RE: TREATY

INTERNATIONAL HEALTH REGULATIONS.

DEAR SIRS.

IT IS THE SUBMISSION OF THIS EXECUTIVE THAT THIS TREATY BE RATIFIED, WE AGREE WITH THE OVERVIEW AND NATIONAL SUMMARY IN RELATION TO THIS TREATY.

THE EXECUTIVE SUPPORT THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION AND THE FINE WORK IT CARRIES OUT. AS NOTED IN THE SUMMARY, CONCERN FOR THE SPREAD OF DISEASE VIA TRADE AND TRAVEL AT INTERNATIONAL LEVEL IS ALSO OF CONCERN TO THIS EXECUTIVE. WE CALL ON THE AUSTRALIAN PARLIAMENT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF INSPECTORS IN THE HEALTH SYSTEM TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF NOT ONLY ANIMALS, BUT ALSO FOR CROPS, PEOPLE IN AND AROUND AUSTRALIA. WE ARE CONCERNED THAT THE SPREAD OF MODERN DISEASES, COULD PLACE THIS GREAT NATION AT RISK. WE ALSO CALL ON THE PARLIAMENT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CUSTOMS STAFF AROUND AUSTRALIA AT THE SMALL AIRFIELDS, AND PORTS.
