I wish to bring to your attention the inadequency of the availability Radio Services available to myself and those of us who live in the Jurien/Badgingarra area of Western Australia.I live on the East Jurien Road,7.5 Kilometres West of the Brand Highway,250 Kilometres north of Perth.

The only reliable Radio signal I can receive is that transmitted through the A.B.C. Transmitter from the Dalwallinu Transmitter.I refer to an AM signal,F.M.is not available,neither are T.V. transmissions. Certain T.V.,reliable,signals are available locally,are available within a limited distance to the residents of the towns of Jurien and Badgingarra,via the installation of local Repeaters.

It is possible you will not receive many responses to your Public notice in the Daily Press,most of us usually take the local ^{OR} Rural Paper.The fact I was in Perth at the time,I happened to come across it as I was in Perth at the time,But Please investigate.
