RADIO INDUSTRY INQUIRY

I wish to make the following submission to the Inquiry, relative to two matters.

Firstly, relative to our local community radio Triple B-FM, which presently transmits on a part time basis. The signal strength for this station is inadequate and therefore broadcasts cannot be heard without a great deal of interference, and in some parts of the area cannot be obtained at all. This makes the success of the station very difficult.

Secondly, radio services in the town of Angaston which is located in a hilly area. No FM radio is received in the town, with the exception of one station which is serviced by a translator station. Even some of the AM stations have a poor quality signal.

Radio quantity and quality in regional and rural Australia should be equal to the service provided to metropolitan/urban areas, and we would like you to make comment and pursue an argument on better services for rural and regional Australia.
