**Convention on the Marking of Plastic Explosives for the Purpose of Detection
National Interest Analysis**

I refer to the National Interest Analysis tabled in Parliament on 11 October 2005 and in particular details contained within the section entitled 'Consultations with non-government organisations'.


In paragraph 8 of that section, information concerning Applied Explosives Technology (AET) stated that *Applied Explosives Technology (AET) responded on behalf of Quin Investments which is the property of AET.*

We have been advised by AET that this statement is incorrect in that Quin Investments is not the property of AET. We advise that the words '*which is the property of AET*' are incorrect and request that the National Interest Analysis be amended to correct this error.
