**Status of Australia's Free Trade Agreement (FTA) partners with respect to
ILO Convention on Labour Inspection (Agriculture) (No. 129) and Minimum Age Convention (No. 138)**

It should be noted that not all ILO Conventions are directly relevant to Australia's obligations under FTAs. Only a limited number of Australian FTAs in force include labour provisions (marked with * in this table). Labour provisions commonly include reference to the *1998 ILO Declaration on Fundamental Principles and Rights at Work and its Follow-Up* (FPRW Declaration) which includes the eradication of child labour. Some FTAs currently being negotiated, such as the Trans Pacific Partnership, also reference the FPRW Declaration.

The majority of Australia's FTA partners have ratified Convention 138 as outlined below. None have ratified Convention 129.
