**Review into re-listing of Kurdistan Workers Party (PKK)**

I refer to the Committee's review of the *Criminal Code Amendment Regulations 2007 (No. 13)* re-listing the Kurdistan Workers Party (PKK) as a terrorist organisation, and to the document outlining the processes for listing the PKK which has previously been forwarded to you.

I advise that on 21 September 2007, the Acting Chief Minister of the Northern Territory, the Hon Syd Stirling, wrote to the Attorney-General advising of the Northern Territory Government's support for the proposed re-listing of the PKK as a terrorist organisation under section 102.1 of the *Criminal Code Act 1995*.
