

Review of Terrorist Organisation Listings

Under section 102.1A of the *Criminal Code Act 1995*, the Parliamentary Joint Committee on ASIO, ASIS and DSD may review a regulation listing a terrorist organisation as soon as possible after the making of a regulation and report the committee's comments and recommendations to each House of the Parliament before the end of the applicable disallowance period, a period of 15 sitting days from the tabling of the regulation.

Under subsection 102.1(3) of the Criminal Code, a regulation ceases to have effect on the second anniversary of the day on which it took effect. The following seven regulations have been made for the purposes of section 102.1 of the Criminal Code on the dates specified:
