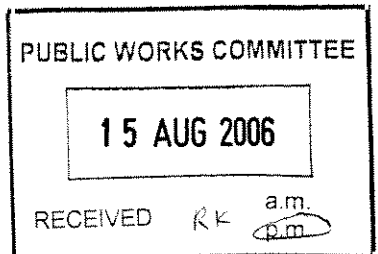

**Proposed Development of Canine Kennelling and Training Facilities for the Australian Federal Police at Majura, ACT**

The Proposed development of the Canine Kennelling and Training Facilities for the Australian Federal Police (AFP) at Majura, ACT outlined in the AFP submission to the Committee dated June 2006, is not directly subject to the provisions of the Australian Government Energy Efficiency Policy

The Department of Environment and Heritage (DEH) the Australian Greenhouse Office (AGO), highly recommends that AFP considers (subject to specific operational, and functional requirements) all appropriate energy efficiency initiatives such as

**Kennels**

- Separate metering for the kennels
- Zoned switching for lighting and heating

**Training Rooms/ office space**

- Lighting no more than 10 watts per m<sup>2</sup> maximum
- Separate metering for tenant light and power and (central service if applicable)
- Zoned switching every 250 m<sup>2</sup> and energy efficient lighting controls

AGO has held discussions with the AFP appreciates their efforts to achieve energy efficiency measures in relation to this facility.
