RECOMMENDATION:

That, in order to provide some benefit to struggling artists, in particular disadvantaged indigenous artist and their heirs, during the introduction of the scheme, for the first five years,:

1. The threshold for payment of royalty to be reduced to \$500.
clause 10(1) (a)

And

2. That on resales of artwork between \$500 and \$1000 which will attract a royalty payment, no administrative fee be charged by the collecting society and that the government compensate the collecting society for this service.
