If SIHIP work is being done under CWES, are payments out of CWES being incorporated into SIHIP costings?

Answer:

The CDEP Work Experience Subsidy (CWES) is a subsidy paid to employers who offer work experience placements to CDEP participants who participate on the program while in receipt of income support. As confirmed by the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations and the Alice Springs Indigenous Coordination Centre, CWES was not claimed nor paid in this instance.
