**Senator Scullion** asked:

Can you provide the value of the SIHIP package – what has actually been released to date of each package – broken down by package.

**Answer:**

As advised in the response to Parliamentary QoN 218 tabled on 23 March 2011, the total value of funds allocated for new housing, rebuilds and refurbishments under the Strategic Indigenous Housing and Infrastructure Program is almost \$550 million\*. The breakdown of this funding by package is as follows:
