### OUTCOME 0: WHOLE OF PORTFOLIO

Topic: HEALTH REFORM TASKFORCE

Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

Health had a 'Reform Taskforce'. In relation to this taskforce, please advise:

- a) What is it doing now?
- b) How many DoHA personnel were on that?
- c) Who are they?
- d) Are they still involved?

### Answer:

- a) The Health Reform Taskforce ceased operation on 30 June 2010.
- b) At its peak, the Taskforce had a total staffing allocation of 42. These numbers fell to 30 by the time the consultation period finished in December 2009.
- c) The table below shows the designation of all staff who worked at the Taskforce at one time or another.
