Notes:

Extra Service Status (ESS) is granted under the *Aged Care Act 1997* in respect of a residential care service (whole service) or a distinct part of a residential care service (distinct part), rather than places.

Extra Service data is collected in relation to when a grant is "activated" (ie the whole service or distinct part has been deemed ready to provide the Extra Services and the first resident is admitted on an Extra Service basis); or not active (ie not yet activated or suspended at the request of the approved provider).

The table above outlines the number of places related to Extra Service grants for each aged care planning region in Western Australia, broken-down by activated and non-activated places (as at 31 December 2010).

Once a grant of Extra Service is made, the grant is not linked to the status of the individual residential places (ie allocated, provisional or operational). The Extra Service data is not analysed under these categories.

b) The following table lists Extra Service Status places as a proportion of the total Mainstream Residential allocated places by aged care planning region at 31 December 2010.

Mainstream Residential allocated places are places in residential facilities operating under the *Aged Care Act 1997*; but which are not Transition Care places or Multi-Purpose Service places.
