How many FaHCSIA funded organisations in Queensland were directly affected by the floods or cyclone? Can you tell me who are the nine FaHCSIA funded services that are not operating?

Answer:

Approximately 1,400 FaHCSIA funded organisations in Queensland were directly affected by the floods or cyclone.

Nine FaHCSIA funded services were unable to operate in varying degrees for approximately 21 days, due to the affects of tropical cyclone Yasi, and these were:
