**Senator Scullion** asked:

Can you provide the number of houses in Wudapuli and Nama that are actually being tenanted and occupied at the moment?

**Answer:**

The Northern Territory has advised that in Wudapuli and Nama, it manages 20 houses under the remote public housing rent framework. These houses are occupied in accordance with tenancy agreements with the Northern Territory Government. Tenants in other houses in the communities are under historical arrangements and no formal tenancy agreements are in place.
