Senator Cash asked:

How many temporary visa holders currently receive FTB Part A? Can you provide a breakdown of this figure by the category of visa held by the recipient?

Answer:

Holders of some temporary visa subclasses may be eligible to receive Family Tax Benefit (FTB).

Holders of Special Category Visa (SCV), which is granted to people who enter Australia on a New Zealand passport, may also be eligible to receive FTB upon meeting a 'residing in Australia' requirement.

As at 28 December 2012, data on number of temporary visa holders receiving FTB Part A is as follows:
