- corporate brand
- speechwriting
- management of the Department's corporate style guides
- management of the Department's photo library
- NAIDOC secretariat and national event.

Individual staff are required to provide any number of these services at any one time. There are no designated graphic designers or event staff. There is one Media Manager and 8.6 media officers.
