How many people from the APY Lands do you expect to enrol - this year - at the Indigenous Land Council's National Indigenous Tourism Training Academy (based at Yulara)?

Answer:

The National Indigenous Training Academy at Ayers Rock Resort (ARR) is currently developing the APY work exposure and work experience program for 2013. The Academy is working with key stakeholders including SA TAFE, the Trade Training Centre in Umuwa and schools in Amata, Ernabella, Fregon, Indulkana, Mimili and Pipalyatjara to develop the program and identify suitable candidates and training requirements.

A structured approach to the APY work exposure and work experience program for 2013 will be provided so that students who are eligible can take up a part-time school based traineeship linked across the National Indigenous Training Academy, ARR, the new Trade Training Centre at Umuwa and their school.
