## **Question:**

a) What about the extra money for the insulin pump program? And it is my understanding is that there was a pre-existing juvenile pump.

b) Is Health the lead agency for the whole strategy and responsible for getting a list of Australian government's expenditure on diabetes?

#### **Answer:**

- a) In 2013-2014, the Government allocated once-off additional funding of \$870,400 to the Insulin Pump Programme. The Programme has an ongoing allocation of \$522,000 per year to 2015-2016. The total allocation for 2013-2014 is \$1.4 million.
- b) The development of a new National Diabetes Strategy is a Coalition election commitment led by the Minister for Health.
