Senator Ludwig asked:

How much was spent on departmental stationery requirements from the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?

Answer:

Department of Social Services

For the period 1 December 2013 to 28 February 2014, the Department's expenditure on stationery was \$161,439 (GST exclusive).

Note: The above expenditure figure includes stationery costs relating to the Indigenous Affairs functions transferring to the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet.

Australian Institute of Family Studies

From the Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date, the Australian Institute of Family Studies has spent \$9,255.34 (ex GST) on departmental stationery requirements.

Australian Aged Care Quality Agency

\$9,995 was spent on departmental stationery requirements.

Aged Care Pricing Commissioner

Stationery requirements are contained in reporting item "Office services and requisites" for the Office of the Aged Care Pricing Commissioner. In the period November 2013 to date, this amount was approximately \$640.15

Aged Care Commissioner

The Office of the Aged Care Commissioner spent \$899.40 incl. GST on stationery and paper costs from November 2013 to date.
