Family Tax Benefit Part A by instalment and lump sum, 2010-11 entitlement year

Note:

As families have up to two years after the end of the entitlement year in which to claim their entitlement to Family Tax Benefit, the 2010-11 entitlement year is considered the most recent complete year.

In this table, lump sum refers to customers receiving payments by lump sum only. Instalment refers to both customers only getting instalment payments and customers who have a mix of claim types.
