- Customer/children's status may change subject to their circumstances and their Family Tax Benefit (FTB) /Income Support Payment eligibility. The reported customer/children eligibility and their status are known as at 31 January 2014.
- Where share care arrangement exists, children may be included more than once.
- For non-FTB customers, the customer is the student who is eligible for the Schoolkids Bonus payment.
- Data for states and territories is derived using the ABS's Australian Statistical Geographical Standard (ASGS).
- Due to rounding, discrepancies may occur between the sum of components and total.
