**Question:**

Can the following details be provided for each discretionary grant program in the Minister's portfolio relating to Sport:

- a) name of the discretionary grant program;
- b) total funding on a year-by-year basis over the current forward estimates;
- c) committed funding on a year-by-year basis over the current forward estimates;
- d) contracted funding on a year-by-year basis over the current forward estimates;
- e) uncommitted funding on a year-by-year basis over the current forward estimates;
- f) when the current round of funding is scheduled to cease; and
- g) how many rounds of funding are scheduled after the end of the current round.

Australian Sports Commission (ASC) response:

The ASC allocates grant funding to sports on an annual basis following consideration and approval by the ASC Board, and where required, the Minister for Sport. The forward estimates are indicative only and are subject to any decisions through the Budget process. Final decisions around grant allocations by the ASC Board will be made after the 2015-16 Budget is handed down. Specific allocations of discretionary grant programs cannot be identified at this stage.
