### **Senator Lines, Sue** asked:

With reference to the Program 1 Deliverables table on p34 of the PBS:

- 1. The number of child care services receiving sustainability assistance declined from 14-15 Budget across the forwards. Can the Department explain this change?
- 2. The number of services receiving establishment services also falls across the forwards. Can the department explain this change?
- 3. Can the department provide a state and territory breakdown of the number of services receiving sustainability assistance, establishment assistance and Budget Based Funding and projections across the forwards?
- 4. Can the Department provide a breakdown of funding under the program including funding for community support, child care quality support, inclusion and professional support, program support and Budget Based Funding and projections across the forwards?

#### **Answer:**

- 1. & 2. The estimated reduction in the number of services receiving sustainability assistance under the Community Support Programme (CSP) across the forward estimates is a result of the introduction of tightened eligibility for Family Day Care services.
