What are the numbers and proportions allocated in level 1, level 2, level 3 and level 4 home care packages since 1 July 2014, by month and state/territory?

**Answer:**

A total of **6,653** home care places were allocated in the 2014 Aged Care Approvals Round (ACAR). All places were allocated in December 2014.
