#### **Senator Lines, Sue** asked:

For each element of the program [Inclusion Support Agency, Specialist Equipment Support, Bicultural Support, Inclusion Support Subsidy], can the Department provide a breakdown of the data, for each of the last 5 years, by;

a. age,

b. state,

c. electorate,

d. type of care?

Can the Department also provide this information for the forward estimates?

#### **Answer:**

- a) The Department of Social Services does not have access to data by age for the Inclusion and Professional Support Program.
- b) Prior to the commencement of the current funding agreement period (1 January 2013), information for each programme element was not consolidated at the jurisdictional level. Tables 1 to 4 outline the allocation of funding for each programme element by state for the current funding agreement period.
