How many children have attracted funding under the Inclusion and Professional Support Program over the last five years?

## Answer:

The Inclusion and Professional Support Program (IPSP) does not provide one-on-one support for individual children. It supports eligible child care and early learning services to include children with ongoing high support needs by increasing the knowledge and skills of educators and the capacity of services. This occurs through the provision of professional development, advice and access to additional resources and support.
