**Topic:** Expenditure on taxis

### **Question:**

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September 2015:

- a) How much did each department/agency spend on taxis during the specified period? Provide a breakdown for each business group in each department/agency.
- b) What are the reasons for taxi costs?
- c) How much did the department spend on taxis during the specified period for their minister or minister's office?

#### Answer:

- a) The department spent \$1.03 million on taxi services from 1 September 2015 to 31 January 2016. Further disaggregation would require an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
- b) Taxis are used for staff travelling for departmental business (for example to attend departmental meetings) and for travel relating to staff attendance at conferences and seminars.
- c) The department spent \$73 on taxi services from 1 September 2015 to 31 January 2016 for the then Minister for Human Services, the Hon Stuart Robert MP.
