#### Notes:

- 1. Transactions for all programmes include those performed through all channels (self-service and digital, online, interactive voice response, Express Plus mobile app, Electronic Data Interchange) and staff-assisted channels (face-to-face and call centres).
- The transaction count does not include third party transactions and payments administered by the department on behalf of other agencies, transfers of monies to customer accounts, or outbound communication through all channels.
- 3. While these transactions are representative of the majority of the work undertaken within the department, there are a number of other payment types and services that have not been included. Including transactions for these excluded payment types and services, would require an unreasonable diversion of departmental resources.
- 4. The numbers reported here may differ slightly to those listed in the Annual Report as some programmes / payments may not be included in the Annual Report.
- 5. Medicare Consumer Enrolment numbers reported in previous versions included all interactions (i.e. paper and digital letters). From 2015-16, data sources became available which allow the distinction between transactions and customer correspondence. The Medicare Consumer Enrolment numbers have been revised to include transaction data only.
