A designated Online Services website publisher is on-call outside regular hours, Monday to Friday from 5pm to 9pm and between the hours of 8.30am to 5pm on Saturday, Sunday and public holidays for the purpose of publishing urgent Ministerial website content. Services available during this time are limited to ministerial media releases, speeches and transcripts that have been submitted by a Communication and Media Branch representative on instruction from the Minister's Office.

Since 14 September 2015 there have been 18 instances of Online Services publishing outside regular hours to maintain the Minister's website.
