Senator Carol Brown asked:

- 1. Does the Minister's office establish KPIs for the drafting of responses for correspondence by the Department? Are there different categories of correspondence with different KPIs?
- 2. Does the Department hold statistics on how many correspondences meet these standards? Do you know how many take 1 month to respond to; 2 months respond to etc?
- 3. When the last ministerial change took place (Morrison to Porter) how many draft responses had to be returned to the Department for redrafting for the new minister?
- 4. How long did it take for all these responses to be redrafted responses to be sent to correspondents?
- 5. Has the Minister's office give any specific direction to the department about dealing with correspondence from non-Government MPs and Senators?

Answer:

- 1. Yes.
- 2. The Department provides reports to the Minister's Office and to the Department's Executive on timeliness of correspondence. The Department does not have specific details on each piece of correspondence.
- 3. There were 635 pieces of correspondence returned to the Department. Not all correspondence returned to the Department was redrafted.
- 4. Timeframes for redrafting correspondence varied depending on the complexity of the issue and any changes to individual circumstances.
