Senator Carol Brown asked:

Can you provide a list of the country of origin of those that are impacted?

Answer:

The measure applies to all pensioners, with less than 35 years Australian Working Life Residence, regardless of their country of birth or country of destination.

However as a guide, the latest published Statistical Overview (2013) shows the highest numbers of people born overseas, receiving a pension in Australia, were born in the following countries:

- United Kingdom 259,444 (11 per cent of total Age Pension population in Australia)
- Italy 109,087 (4.6 per cent of total Age Pension population in Australia)
- Greece 71,886 (3.1 per cent of total Age Pension population in Australia)
- New Zealand 41,383 (3.1 per cent of total Age Pension population in Australia)
