#### Senator Carol Brown asked:

Please provide the number of people expected to be eligible for the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) in each electorate by the completion of full rollout.

#### **Answer:**

It is estimated that at the completion of full Scheme rollout (30 June 2019) there will be approximately 460,000 participants eligible for the NDIS across Australia. This estimate is based on the original modelling completed by the Productivity Commission.

Specific granular geographical estimates are not easily derived due to the lack of available disability data at this level of detail. However, the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) has made estimates by Local Government Area (2011) across Australia and this can be mapped to electoral boundaries (2013).

Electoral boundaries have been redistributed. In the future, the NDIA will develop estimates for new electoral boundaries. However, to do so now would require a diversion of NDIA resources.

The tables at <u>Attachment A</u> outline the estimated number of participants eligible for the NDIS in each electorate by state/territory as at 30 June 2019. Note that estimates are not available for the two Australian Capital Territory electorates.
