### **Question:**

- a) What was the total cost (GST <u>inclusive</u>) of subscriptions to print and online news services, newspapers, magazines, journals and periodicals etc in calendar year 2016 for the Department? Please provide a complete list of each service to which the Department subscribed.
- b) What was the total cost (GST <u>inclusive</u>) of subscriptions to print and online news services, newspapers, magazines, journals and periodicals etc in calendar year 2016 for Ministers in the portfolio? Please provide a complete list of each service to which ministerial offices subscribed.

#### Answer:

- a) The Department spent \$280,679 on all subscriptions and publications which include purchase of books (technical and non-technical), videos, periodicals, journals and newspapers. There is no central register of service details. For the Department to provide the cost of print and online news services only and a specific breakdown of subscriptions would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.
- b) The Department spent \$11,237. The following newspaper and digital media subscriptions were provided to the Minister's office:
  - Australian Financial Review;
  - Daily Telegraph;
  - Herald Sun;
  - Melbourne Herald Sun;
  - o Sydney Morning Herald; and
  - o The Age;
  - o The Australian; and
  - The Economist.
