Question:

a) How much did the Department spend on stationery and office supplies in calendar year 2016 (GST <u>inclusive</u>)?

- b) How much did the Department spend on paper in calendar year 2016 (GST <u>inclusive</u>)?
- c) What brand of paper does the Department use?
- d) Is this paper Australian made?
- e) If no, why doesn't the Department buy Australian made paper?

Answer:

- a) The Department's spend on stationery and office supplies (excluding paper) in calendar year 2016 was \$3,398,978 (GST inclusive).
- b) The Department's spend on paper in calendar year 2016 was \$1,848,295 (GST inclusive).
- c) The brands of paper the Department uses are as follows:
 - Australian;
 - Reflex:
 - Staples; and
 - Impact.
- d) Australian, Reflex and Staples paper are Australian made. Impact paper is not Australian made.
- e) Of the paper used by the Department, 96 per cent is Australian made. Impact paper is available for selection as one of a number of paper options that has been put in place by the Department of Finance, under the Whole of Australian Government Stationery and Office Supplies contract.
