What are the average wait times by states for metropolitan and regional areas for clients to be assessed by a member of the My Aged Care Regional Assessment Service (RAS)/an Aged Care Assessment Team (ACAT) once a referral to My Aged Care has been submitted?

Answer:

The basis for assessment for RAS & ACATs currently differs. RAS assessments are conducted in accordance with Aged Care Planning Regions and ACATs operate within boundaries based on Statistical Local Areas. Within the respected regions/areas, there are both metropolitan and regional areas. Average wait times for metropolitan and regional areas by state are not available.
