## Question:

a) What proportion of grant requests did NHMRC fund last financial year? b) How has this changed over time? Please provide this data for each year from FY2010-11 to FY2015-16. i. Please explain the reasons for variances in the data.

## Answer:

a) The following table shows the overall funded rate for competitive National Health and Medical Research Council (NHMRC) grants since 2010 by calendar year. NHMRC reviews and awards grants on a calendar year basis.

## NHMRC funded rates for Competitive Grants 2010 to 2016

| 2010 | 4798 | 1244 | $25.90 \%$ | $\$ 727.6$ million |
| 2011 | 5030 | 1334 | $26.50 \%$ | $\$ 778.4$ million |
| 2012 | 5249 | 1275 | $24.30 \%$ | $\$ 826.4$ million |
| 2013 | 5579 | 1220 | $21.90 \%$ | $\$ 775.2$ million |
| 2014 | 5572 | 981 | $17.60 \%$ | $\$ 844.3$ million |
| 2015 | 5847 | 1030 | $17.60 \%$ | $\$ 889.9$ million |
| 2016 | 5519 | 986 | $17.90 \%$ | $\$ 817.6$ million |

i. Funded rates have declined since 2010 and are currently 17-18 per cent. While annual funding has remained stable, funded rates have declined for a number of reasons including:

- Increase in application numbers
- Increase in requested budgets
- Increase in the number of funded large clinical trials and cohort studies
