4 A decision by the SSAT to set aside or vary a decision under review does not necessarily mean that the applicant was successful on the review. The decision of the SSAT is less favourable to an applicant in some cases.

\* Note that in Change of Assessment reviews the liability to pay child support is likely to be affirmed but the amount of the liability may be varied.
