**Senator Edwards** asked:

What happens to those individuals on income management who leave the Playford area?

**Answer:**

**Voluntary and Vulnerable measures**

When a person moves outside a declared income management area they continue to participate in income management under that measure unless they are no longer eligible.

**Child Protection measure**

If a person being income managed under the child protection measure moves outside of the Playford LGA, income management continues for that person until the relevant child protection authority revokes the notice or the notice ends, or until they lose eligibility.

**Feasibility**

The Commonwealth can determine at any point in time that it is no longer feasible to apply income management to a person. Considerations when determining feasibility include, but are not limited to, the availability of infrastructure (e.g. for BasicsCard) and support services (e.g. Financial Management Program services) in the new location.
