## Question:

Senator SMITH: What is the approximate number of clients of the agency?
Ms Clapin: We have approximately 200,000 clients who are what we call active clients, so they pay their annual maintenance fee.

Senator SMITH: Are you able to provide that on a state-by-state or territory-byterritory breakdown?
Ms Clapin: We would have to take that on notice.

## Answer:

Australian Hearing has approximately 200,000 active clients. The table below shows the percentage breakdown by State and Territory.

| State/Territory | Active Clients |
| :--- | :---: |
| Australian Capital Territory | $1.5 \%$ |
| New South Wales | $32.7 \%$ |
| Northern Territory | $1.3 \%$ |
| Queensland | $22.1 \%$ |
| South Australia | $4.8 \%$ |
| Tasmania | $5.0 \%$ |
| Victoria | $26.3 \%$ |
| Western Australia | $6.3 \%$ |

An active client is defined as:

- a client that has a current hearing services card or is in the process of obtaining one;
- an aided child or young adult with a current hearing aid; and
- an unaided child that has had a clinical service within the last 12 months.
