For example, in 2011-12 the Department delivered 2,700 Financial Information Services seminars across the country and provided tea, coffee and biscuits at these events. In addition, CRS Australia holds a number of customer meetings for job seekers and employer workgroups on a regular basis where tea, coffee and biscuits are provided.
