Senator Wright asked:

Can the agency confirm what funds have been spent to date, and allocated over the forward estimates, under the NDIS Sector Development Fund? a. Who has received or been allocated this funding, and for what purposes? b. How much is currently unallocated? c. What will the priorities for investment be, in allocating these funds?

Answer:

The Federal Government made approximately \$149 million available over five years to 2016-17 for the Sector Development Fund. Approximately \$46.8 million has been expended or committed to date.
