#### **Senator Moore** asked:

Can the Department provide an itemised explanation of all elements of the process of funding for gambling in DSS?

### **Answer:**

In the 2014-15 Department of Social Services Portfolio Budget Statements (PBS), the funding for gambling is captured under <u>Outcome 2.1 – Families and Communities</u>, as part of <u>Financial Wellbeing and Capability</u>.

Gambling is not a separate line item in the PBS, and is reported under Financial Wellbeing and Capability, in table 2.2.1 'Expenses for Families and Communities' (page 98).
