a. How many families are expected to be affected by this measure?
b. How many children are expected to be affected by this measure?

## Answer:

The table below shows the estimated number of families and children to be affected by limiting the Large Family Supplement (LFS) to four or more children each year.

|  | 2014-15 | $\mathbf{2 0 1 5 - 1 6}$ | $\mathbf{2 0 1 6 - 1 7}$ | $\mathbf{2 0 1 7 - 1 8}$ |
| :--- | ---: | ---: | ---: | :---: |
| a)Estimated number <br> of families <br> affected by LFS <br> reform | - | 383,000 | 375,500 | 371,600 |
| b)Estimated number <br> of children <br> affected by LFS <br> reform | - | 383,000 | 375,500 | 371,600 |

*Note: the estimated number of children is for the third child in a family who will lose eligibility for LFS.
All families with three or more children will lose LFS for the third child only. Therefore the number of families and the number of children impacted are the same.
